



Heaven on Earth Society for Animals FUR Foster Agreement



By entering into a partnership with Heaven on Earth Society for Animals (HESA), you agree to abide by the terms of this agreement as outlined below:

1. I am making a commitment to provide love, safety, and humane care for the cat(s) which I have agreed to care for in my home until they are adopted into permanent homes. I understand that this may take weeks or even months.
2. I will provide, at my own expense, food, litter, and all other supplies relating to adequate and appropriate care. **HESA will provide basic medical care, including and limited to, vaccinations, deworming and flea control as needed.** Any other medical care, due to conditions pre-existing or subsequent to my partnership with HESA, may be discussed with HESA's Medical Review Committee for potential assistance with the costs, though HESA is under no obligation to assist.
3. I have disclosed all information about the cat that may impact an adoption including, but not limited to, behavioral problems, pre-existing medical problems, socialization problems, or litter box problems.
4. **I understand that the cat(s) I am placing through HESA must be tested for Feline Leukemia (FeLV) and FIV and spayed or neutered at my own expense. I will keep the cat(s) separate from any untested cats. I understand HESA encourages testing for my own cats.**
5. **I WILL KEEP THE CATS I AM FOSTERING INDOORS AT ALL TIMES.**
6. I will not put the cat(s) up for adoption until they are healthy. If they are kittens, they must be least two pounds in weight (approximately 8 weeks old); at that time, the kitten is usually old enough to be spayed or neutered. Under no circumstances will I adopt out a cat or kitten through HESA until it has been spayed or neutered. I understand that in Los Angeles, it is required by law to spay and neuter any cats over 4 months of age.
7. I will abide by the policies endorsed by HESA relative to what constitutes a suitable home outlined in my informational packet.
8. **I will transport or arrange for transportation of the cat(s) to and from weekend adoption events regularly until adopted.**
9. If I choose to stay during the adoption events, I will abide by the same guidelines regarding arrival, set up, breakdown, adoption screening, etc. which all HESA volunteers are expected to follow.
10. **I will work with and keep up-to-date medical records of all medical care and bring copies of the records with the cat(s) to all adoption events. It is my responsibility to make sure that all treatments for the cat(s) are current.**
11. If, in the future I am no longer able or willing to foster the cat(s), I will either:
 - a) Make arrangements for them to be fostered by another FUR Foster, until they are placed in permanent homes, or
 - b) Reimburse HESA if they assisted in any payments for medical care provided to the cat(s) and place them on my own.
12. If my cat(s) are given up in the future by their adopter, I will do my best to accept them back into foster care until they are placed again.
13. I understand that HESA is a non-profit organization and asks for adoption fees to support the organization's medical, operational and administrative costs. I can request reimbursement for my expenses up to the cost of the adoption fee if I so choose. I understand that I must submit receipts and an expense report within sixty (60) days of the adoption to receive reimbursement. I also understand that if I place the cat on my own, then I am not entitled to receive reimbursement from HESA.
14. I understand that HESA may rescind this agreement for failure to comply with any provision herein or any other HESA policy or procedure, at which time clause 11(b) shall become effective.
